18 Misty morning cloudy and sunny very warm sunshine warm day. I went to Andersons got lend of his draining implement we worked it in drain No 4 I took it back at night got loaf bread at 7 wots 10 cts. Armstrongs rig brought up basket peaches 70 cts 8 gems on apr. Miss Jean Phillips up in P.M.

Tuesday

Warm day sunny and cloudy thunder and lightning and rain at night Willie cultivated stumpfield No 7 in A.M. and plowed 4 horses No 1 sod in P.M. I went to Elora in buggy in A.M. left order with Mr Brohman for drain cultivator and some bags at Salems mill for bran. I got at Mermies 1 qt floor paint 40 cts turpentine 10 cts paint jar Young in full for pulling flax \$1.25 got at Armstrongs 1 lb sugar greens 20. including daisy seed 10 cts barley 10 cts I worked at drain No 4 in P.M.
