Conclusions Concerning Anesthetics.

Local anesthesia with cocaine and similar agents has a limited field of usefulness. The amount of cocaine employed by infiltration should always be short of a toxic dose, I-10 to $\frac{1}{4}$ of a grain. It should be employed in normal salt solution with small amounts of adrenalin. Where the amount does not exceed I-19 of a grain it may safely be preceded by a small dose of morphine and scopolamin.
