25 Monday, Jimmie & Pa went to the funeral of Mrs George Munday. Mrs Duncan Church had died last night. The wind is cold. They had a telegram from Murdy from Vancouver. Candy is all right. Sent an order to Kennie for seeds.

26 Birdie & myself went to Chris Holms and called at Ross on our return

27 Mrs L. Holm was buried today a large funeral. Joe Ann McLean called today. Had a letter from her

28 Cold last wind. 1 lb tea 25. 70 butter 60 Marion got samples from Eatons

29 Fine dry weather. no vegetation good and cool for seeding

30 Fine day. Jimmie went to Alexandra with D.K. to Archie McThuis funeral. Mary McIntyre went to see Peter and the Marchisons

May 1898

1 Sunday Rev Haste of Cornwall preached in the morning. Gooden Smith in the evening. Mr Given was in Cornwall

2 Fine day. done some washing

3 Baked in oven. not good bread

4 70 1 lb tea 25; butter 50.

5 Birdie and I were at woman's meeting at A. G. McDonalds. I paid my fee 1.00

6 Jimmie is mending. M. J. Huggins. To stew 25-

7 Done a little in garden. sowed onions, beets, carrots, mangolds, lettuce summer sowing on the 4th. The raspberry strawberry came today I planted it

8 Fine day. the wind keeps cold

9 Mary left today for Arguehuts. An old man Smith came for her

10 We planted the post office lot with potatoes today

11 Began to rain. Papa & Jimmie went to Salway farm and sowed a mixture of Timothy & grasses

12 Cold and a slow drizzle. Had a turkey, eggs

13 Cold and raw. Had 1 lb sausage. 30. stew 20

14 Worked in garden

15 A large congregation. Uncle Donald and Mary age were here

16 Worked & worked in garden. Had Rue all day. planted corn. some top onions cucumbers. fixed strawberries. Murdy came

17 Had Rue p day. planted 3 rows top onion 4 rows of carrots. To buy & frost 53 cts Murdy has a gum boil, he caught cold on the train. and was sick. and did not remain in Toronto. There was a thunder storm last night. a good deal of rain fell. Sent the cows to pasture. The white cow was sent to Salways
