- 6 rain most of the day I went to Fairfax
with Rev Mr Millard there was only Mr Donavan
and Miss Clear there the Session met one day Sa
7 Philo took me to Fairfax to the Communion
Rev Mr Millard preached there was a
good meeting and fine day
- 8 Ad & Tonnie dug potatoes and took a waggon
to Ad that was all that they dug
- 9 very hard frost this morning Ad and Tonnie
dug potatoes the Blue potatoe is best for taste
- 10 Ad plowed in the South East field Tonny
dug potatoes in the afternoon he was sick in the
afternoon & cleaned up the old barn floor
- 11 the thrashers came last night it is the Wams
they thrashed the Wheat and all other peas
oats & Black barley there 72 of wheat and
373 of the mixter they done by noon there 15 more
- 12 Ad went to Escott with fifteen bags of the
mixter he got home by noon and put the bags
in heavy rain all the afternoon & evening
- 13 Ad plowed 3ac in the North field
Rev Mr Millard preached the morning
- 14 Ad plowed in the North field one day again
rain this morning Ad plowed in the North field at night
- 15 Ad plowed in the North field one day again
