May went down town before dinner took to Russells 12 doz eggs @ 18¢ = 2.16 got groceries 40 balance in dc \$1.76 got at Amstrongs goods 42 (15 7¢) also goods in dc 45 she brought another up and in P.M. we cut seed potato we spread 2 loads P.M. from yard planted 2 rows potatoes Row North early No 1, 2. cutting from mangels. Willie drove another down at night Jess in buggy. Gess sick 5

Mr Gess over P.M. put in first and most of garden. Sold Bob Lindale 1 lb butter 19 cts. Willie down town at night got meat Bargin 50 cts sent to Waterloo for millet seed \$2.50 postage & order 5
