 5 wind, looked like rain, and today
 6 it was quite cool mercury down to
 7 60. Jimmie ploughed the lot at the home
 8 farm, Gorgeon lot & harrowed the
 9 potatoes, ploughed Sam lot yesterday
 10 Bently paid \$4.⁰⁰
 11 Muddy planted corn in home lot
 12 Womens meeting at Mrs M Gairns I done some
 13 sewing for myself, and gave 5cts
 14 Professor & Mrs Ferguson were there
 15 I washed Aunt's blankets and am baking
 16 I will not get the bread in oven
 17 until after dark, got 1 pm bread 25
 18 Ran got boots charged at Willis's 3.25. w x 20 3.45
 19 The days are hot Hatty was here
 20 Sir John died last night 10.15. and
 21 Colonel Fraser of Fraser's Point was buried
 22 here today, he was 90 years old
 23 Got at Willis's 1 lb tea Jimmie sowed buck
 24 wheat. Jimmie & Muddy were in Cornwall
 25 Saturday Got Table shod Friday & Jettys
 26 today, Muddy went with Duncan Mc Lellan P. B.
 27 Muddy got home in afternoon, we covered
 28 horse corn in Garden lot, Monday
 29 got 1/2 bush of corn from Shedd's 65cts
 30 Dolly had a mare colt on Monday
 31 I sent a letter to Lutch & Pringle
 32 Pa and G. Gabbis left about 7 for Alex
 33 andries on route for Ottawa to attend
 34 Sir John's funeral. He lies in state in
 35 the parliament building since
