25 Fine sunny warm day breezy. N.S. up all day he had turnips second time I finished scuffling turnips also shot rows of corn. We cut some more hay No 6 AM. PM we scuffled rape at 7 I had some turnips, I D Robert cut hay and took it in 2 loads other from one here. Willie dropped some. Andrew Schons paid for gillys 85

Sunday

26 Cloudy and sunny. Mr Graw preceded AM from Matt 4:1-11. and in evening from Auntie back from Toronto Willie at home AM only he down at night. L.A. roll 10cts. 10

Monday

27 Mostly cloudy rained a few drops AM N.S. up all day he raked rappings No 6 then he and Willie took raps down to camera 4 59 sold on 18th see balance \$75.00 Willie got at Manias hired 75 00 oil 15 starch at Ellis 10, at 7 & D wheat \$1.84 bran \$1.50 10 3 49 wool oil 60 soap 30. PM we finished scuffling rape potatoes & some were also finished No 2 rappings took in. No 6 rappings. I cut some more hay No 6 after tea.
