The essential cause of the Anemia which sometimes follows typhoid is often an "iron poor" milk diet, prolonged for several weeks. The resulting blood state, and the prostration incident to a long continued illness, urgently calls for hematinic and supportive measures during convalescence. **Pepto-Mangan (Gude)** eligibly supplies the essential material for hematic reconstruction and general constitutional revitalization.
