The Eye in Diagnosis—(Continued).

Infectious Diseases.

(a) Cerebro spinal meningitis causes paralysis of the extrinsic muscles, ptosis, and abnormalities of the pupil.

(b) Diphtheria causes paralysis of accommodation of external muscles, usually the external rectus.

Erysipelas causes sometimes Orbital cellulitis.

Purulent conjunctivitis and iritis are usually caused by the gonococcus.—*Russell; Diet & Hyg. Gazette.*
