I & H brought 30 bus turpiss from  
Thomas H got more Bonnie shot  
then they drew some dung W. fine  
strong west wind I B<sup>r</sup> called Pm  
B went with Jo Man Jesse Shank  
Redding suckers This evening they  
sold about 100 @ 25¢ per doz  
17 Bap plowed Mangel ground I  
harrowed with Colts H worked  
at Johnny Russors Pm W. fine & warm  
18 Sowed Mangels & 6 drills feed Corn  
in west end of N E corner field H  
worked at Johnny Russors Am

H & girls <sup>May 1892</sup> & Nancy went to Widemuir's  
meeting house Pm Funck Party done  
some Baptizing Old Wimer & Haber  
from Waterloo officiated for them  
I & A took Colts Fly & Polly to  
Crawfords after dinner W. fine  
warm, strong W. wind.  
19 Bap drew dung on turning ground I  
collet at Jo Am Chored Pm  
W. strong very strong east wind  
Am rain Pm R Wallace was  
here at noon & Pm  
20 Bap all helped I make fence  
I & Nancy went to Markham Am  
to Dentist got Nancy's teeth fixed  
I & Susanna went to Pierce's field  
Picked a lot of Mushrooms  
W. rather cloudy. Cleared up fine  
21 Chored Cleaned grit last of  
Wheat about 25 Bus. B<sup>r</sup> Jo David  
& Bertha brought 4 young Funckites  
from Waterloo to supper W. rain all  
day more or less  
Monday 22 at home all day W. Cloudy  
drizzly rain through the middle  
of the day
