snowing all day. Monday 27th.

Fine the fore part of the day but clouded over in the afternoon. Father and Robert. Underbrushing. Fred and Phillips hunting the beech after butter.

Tuesday 28th.

Dull in the morning. Fine in the afternoon. Underbrushing in the morning but after turnips in the afternoon.

Wednesday 29th.

Cloudy with sunshine at intervals. Finished pulling the white turnips and carted 15 bag full into the cellar.

Thursday 30th.

Sharp wind and snowing most of the time.

### December.

Friday 1st.

Very strong wind with snow. Ground a little corn. Mercifully cold.

Saturday 2nd.

Fine cool and cloudy. Underbrushing. Cutting firewood.

Sunday 3rd.

Cold and snowing all day.

Monday 4th.

Went Underbrushing but the cold was so intense we were
