 sawing an old oak on the Lower Point Rowena very

 off left their Boat made a Trip to Lunenburg
 before they went of got a Lamp from Philip
 left their lines and some snoods as we got a sturgeon
 from them left the Key Mc Martin was went to
 Summers town sent a letter to Dan M
 Bought of Mr Ward Flour 1.25 Thread 15 Soap
 10 paid this Bought of Nicholens 15 lb Sugar 1.5
 Raisins 5 Postage 3 crags taken their cattle from
 Francis Island I Summers away hunting Deer
 Nomination Day in Alexandria for Dan M
 12th Drove up the Boats and Bed at the Par
 Covered the new stable with Marsh hay 2
 Drove some Boards from the Shanty 13th 2 W
 Snowing Stormy 14th Windy Drifting 15th Killed

 and put the Sugar in it ^(I made up 2 gallons) about 5 3 lbs 16th

 Bohemian all night in Lancaster. 23rd
 W Raining & froze some last night changed
 to West Fishing in place for the sheep to be
 by themselves The Government sale of Tools
 they had working at the Wharf to day
 Summerston Rowena not well to
 day 24th John H. and I up to the Head of the
 land had the croquet saw marked a Blittermist
 tree that fell with the Wind piled some of the
 roughs West Wind 25th St Catharine's Day
 Bohemian went down a Jug Towing her
 Wind high snowing got a ground below
 uppers Island Mr. Donald and Eugene here
 going to Hungary Bay to look for the Drowned men
