Local Treatment of Erysipelas.

The author employs a solution of 20 drops of phenol in 25 gm. of pure neutral glycerin. No danger attends absorption of the phenol, erysipelatous patients showing a high degree of tolerance to this substance. The involved area, together with a zone of skin surface surrounding it, is simply painted with the solution. The glycerin avoids excessive irritation of the skin, but the preparation should not be brought in contact with mucous membranes.—Lodi; Gazzetta degli Ospedali.
