- Sun Dec 30. Fine day. Mother and the girls here for tea. I went to Fisherville. Mr. McTaggart preached. It rained in the night very heavily. Uncle took Tom home. Sleighing nearly all gone.
- Mon Dec 31. Rained a little very mild, last time cutter was out. Jennie Green here to spend the day. Uncle took her to the Station. I waited till train left.
