Fine sunny warm day breezy cloudy by night
 We finished seeding to-day by sowing rest of
 pease bottom of stump field No 7. We disked
 garden and new orchard before noon. J. Martind
 in AM looking at cattle pig etc. PM we spread
 2 loads manure with spreader one from pig pen
 one from yard. then Willie harrowed pease
 and I made some more manure drills.
 Mr Dance got load hay PM (Jim Anderson's man
 Simie and waggon) J. Miller had trip over to-day.
 We gave last week 2 blabsters to T.A. 24th Restaurant.

Thursday

Rainy AM cloudy day some sun
 PM rain at night again. Willie took 2250 lbs
 pig horse & cow chaf down to Welons AM \$110 paid
 for last 37. got hay ticket 10 paid Berzin for
 meat got last week 45 sent for hair dye 30cts
 got at Menno in aft paid 50 blabsters 25. I don't
 know where the sheep were etc. PM Willie cultivated
 No 7 W grass upland 3 horses I sowed 8 or 12 rows
 manure drills had better with wet land and wet seed. I went
 over the drills with weeds then raked after
 tea was coming down 12th row when I noticed
 sward blocked with seed hence left it there. Willie
 took 2 doz eggs to counting in aft \$2.16
