- 2 I was not in church today. Rained all day.
- 3 Uncle Hugh was buried. Murdy & Birdie went and Far & Jimmie
- 4 Jimmie drove Far to Sumner station paid for to Mary for the butter
- 5 Wednesday. Jimmie and Murdy went to Lancaster
- 6 W. F. M. I met at M. Cummins I did not go but sent my off 25.⁰⁰ Sold 2 doz eggs 23⁰⁰ got 1 bottle Carters little pills 25 and 21.
- 7 Pa still in bed had a letter from Uncle Sandy. Lygze was married on Monday 3rd Got the parcel from Washington yesterday that Marion sent in January. 1 big collar, 1 little one, 1 kerchief, 1 linen doily and ~~the~~ to work it. Boys went out to Jiques to see the bush. Rain from 10 A.M. until 4 P.M. Sent a short letter to Marion
- 8 Fine bright day. cold high wind, boy drew a jug of stew. Katie & Jimmie. Birdie and I done a little sewing for Mrs Ellis
- 9 Pa is not ^{with} recovering. A large congregation
10. Murdy left by Moyasson for Glen Robertson
11. Jimmie was at Maxwell last night. did not come home until this morning. Murdy got home last night. Sold 3 doz eggs at Wallis. Got sugar 25 tea 25. soap 10. 7 1/2 lbs meat 18⁰⁰ Heard last night. That General Methuen, was wounded & captured

- 11 on Friday morning March 7th, he is said to have had 1200 men. lost four guns. three officers 38 men killed. five officers & 70 men wounded, one officer & 200 men missing. Delacroy is the boer general who captured Methuen. 3-40 P.M. raining
- 12 Still digging. Pa is not better. D. Mowet in 10 P.M. and left a bottle of Prohume
- 12 Still raining. cleaned the furnace pipes. A great scare of small pox in the vicinity. A meeting called for tonight. to have all houses quarantined. that have the small pox
13. Birdie and Murdy got vaccinated last night. It is said that there will be an expert come from Toronto to see if it is small small pox or chicken pox
14. Fine day. D. called to see Pa give him 1 bottle medicine. The expert came and pronounced it small pox. Jimmie and Lygze called and returned to tea. Sold 3/4 doz eggs - 22⁰⁰ got 3/4 lb dried apples 4, 1 lb rice 20⁰⁰ should be wheat 15. Murdy got honey 30⁰⁰ 2 cans strawberry butter 57.
- 15 Pa is not gaining. To three lbs less 30 Methuen, it said. has been liberated
16. In morning showing. fair in afternoon. Birdie went to see Aunt Kate and found her nice. The D. was in at 5 P.M. gave nothing to Pa. It rained from 5 P.M. until now 9 P.M. and is still raining
17. St. Patrick's day. Strong west wind. Pa had a severe tummy from 2 A.M. until 4 A.M. Pa had bread
18. Cold bright day D. in in morning, gave Pa a injection. Sold 2 1/2 doz eggs 15.00 = 38. To 1 Electric oil 25 salt 10. nutmeg 3 = 38. Took 1.00 of Birdie's to buy butter. D. M. Luman came with Mowet. at 5 P.M. said Pa
