 Bought of Mr Mc Gillis 100  
 Sap Buckets 8 Dollars spent  
 75 cents 2 of the Galer neas  
 cropped up here going to Dundee  
 Stanley and I cutting in the  
 oakfield Drawing Wood to  
 the House Went to the E & L Island  
 on the north side 3 Teams to Day  
 Drawing from Suppers Island  
 Heard Ducks going down this morning  
 some one shooting up the front  
 this afternoon Mr W Dunlop and  
 George Delmo called here as they  
 were going to Cornwall to a Masonic  
 meeting. I treated me to a Drop of Good Stuff  
 and cigars Heard Mrs George Annan  
 Departed on the 19th

 Fernandez went to Lancaster  
 one of the cows calved Leander  
 went to Dundee took a Tub  
 of Butter a lot of Teams to Charlie  
 and Ross's Island not very  
 well to Day 150 Wt of Flour  
 sack of fine Salt 6 lbs Sea  
 22<sup>nd</sup> Livinia B Day 8 snow very  
 fine Day Mrs George Annan  
 Wife Buried today Gordon  
 at Wake and Funeral Drawing  
 the Sticks for the stable and  
 some Wood cutting stone wood  
 and sawing and splitting one  
 more of the cows calved Took  
 up the slabs from the shore at  
 the shanty 23<sup>rd</sup> fine Day  
 3 Went to Lancaster to Day  
 Fernandez changed his Boots  
 Gordon Bought a pair of Pants  
 Bought a Sugar Pan 4 Dollars  
 Bought 3 Bunches of Shingles  
 Got the Soft Maple Lumber Sounded  
 and Grooved 472 Feet  
 Paid the Shingles
