 Burkhole's with Dr Lisans who is operating  
 on Uncle Joseph by cutting for stone in the  
 bladder. Brought Dr with me this evening  
 W. very cold. pretty heavy N.W. wind  
 27 Nabe gave birth to a son about 1.00  
 this A.M. doing very well. I took Mc  
 home A.M. Chored P.M. W. very cold yet  
 28 Drove 9 load wood for Steele W. pretty cold  
 Uncle Joseph died this morning  
 29 Brought horse power from Flavin's A.M. I own  
 the whole machine now bought out Flavin's  
 & having bought out B.C. last winter  
 Finlans were here today W. fine  
 March 1st Uncle Joseph was buried today  
 I didn't go My Mother went with A.B. W.  
 B.C. Is here here this evening <sup>clear</sup> cold  
 2 Chored. W. fine. Clear Nancy & baby  
 doing fine  
 Sunday 3 Meeting at Hebron I didn't go  
 Old M. Neighbourhoods & young Morts  
 were here W. fine Clear  
 4 Chored. very very cold. N.W. wind all  
 5 Chored. W. Clear. Calm. biting. Cold  
 6 Went to Flavin's sale thought Neakyoke  
 2 50<sup>cts</sup> Waggon sack 75<sup>cts</sup> Cider barrel \$4.00 &  
 Pair Bobolinks \$16.00. W. severe cold heavy  
 north wind. Flavin's has rented his farm to  
 J. N. Hall & he is putting up a house on the north end  
 of his farm on the 4<sup>th</sup> concession for himself

Brought home my purchases from Flavin's A.M.  
 Went to Cedar Grove 8 M. W. mild  
 8 Went to Cherrywood that is Walkey's Corner  
 A.M. with Old buggy. went to Martham P.M. mild  
 9 Went to Martham to make affidavit as  
 witness to the will of my little Uncle Joseph  
 Burkhole's at the Office of A. Thoms  
 W. East storm snow & drizzle rain all day  
 didn't amount to much after all  
 Sunday 10 at home B.C. Flavin's & Isaac Reesor were  
 here Cobin called a little while W. mild the  
 snow yesterday helped the sleighing a good deal  
 11 Went to J.D.'s & to Cedar Grove A.M. Simon Hoover  
 were here when I got home. W. fine warm. Clear  
 12 Chored & got horse power set. made ready for sleighing  
 W. fine warm. Clear. Thawing. There has still been thin  
 sleighing so far. but it appears it won't last much  
 13 Threshed A.M. got on very well. Put <sup>longer</sup> through over  
 200 bus oats A.M. got done before dinner. W. fine A.M.  
 Cloudy P.M. Heard that Michael Burkhole's little  
 boy about 7 years old got accidentally hung in a  
 Cow Chain yesterday evening  
 14 Chored A.M. went to funeral of M. Burkhole's  
 boy at Hebron P.M. W. fine. Clear. snowing tonight  
 15 Chored. I & little boys got a grist ready P.M. Jacob  
 Grove & family were here P.M. W. Clear sharp  
 16 Went to Cherrywood A.M. & to Cedar Grove  
 with grist Chop P.M. W. Clear sharp  
 Sunday 17 at home B.C. N. & B.C. D. Gough's  
 were here. W. Clear sharp a little snow squalls  
 18 Helped B.C.'s hang up pork A.M. Got mine out of tubs  
 P.M. W. Clear sharp. Commenced to snow from East  
 very heavy this evening about sunset  
 19 Hung up our Pork. R.W. & W.M. helped. W. heavy  
 N.W. wind all day. Cold. drifting snow  
 20 Chored. I & little John cut some shingles W. cold  
 21 I & little girls <sup>very cold</sup> & John went to Martham & to J. A. Reesor  
 for dinner. W. pretty cold N.W. wind with good sleighing in the  
 ditches along the fences. all the gullies are solid ice
