Rectal Hints.

Be suspicious of carcinoma when you obtain the following history in a patient over thirty-five: Diarrhea for the past months, preceded by a short period of constipation. The diarrhea at first is limited to the day; later the patient awakens at night with an intense desire to empty the bowels. He rushes to stool only to find that he is unable to pass anything but a little blood. This recurs four or five times each night and more frequently during the day. Loss in weight may be only slight.—Wagner; Int. Journ. of Surg.
