 Comes W. fine rain last night Clear today
 26 Cleaned up barn floor & turned Peas, finished drawing
 in Peas 2 loads & a load fence Comes day P.M. W. fine cool clear
 27 I & C drew in spring wheat 9 loads Nancy helped
 unload P.M. W. fine
 28 I, C. & Flavis drew in Oats 10 loads, W. fine warm clear
 29 I began raking spring wheat stubble Finlans Come A.M.
 Charrowed us follow A.M. he helped I D.P.M. I & Flavis cut
 nearly all Oats below Orchard P.M. W. very warm close
 30 I finished raking spring wheat stubble Charrowed them
 we cut last Oats till noon bound them P.M. W. warm close
 Sunday 31 We & my Mother went to A.B.'s. W. Showed best
 Sept 1 I & C ridged up, fine rain last night ^{night} windy today
 2 I sowed 4 acres wheat for B. N. A.M. he plowed for me
 3 I & C finished plowing till 4 P.M. drew in big load spring wheat
 raking this evening, W. Cloudy drizzling tonight
 4 Chored A.M., began to sow wheat about 3 P.M. W. rainy A.M.
 5 I finished sowing & harrowing wheat, C helped B. N. C. Plow
 6 C furrowed out wheat field & I went to Cal. Grove A.M.
 I & Flavis drew in Oats below Orchard 3 loads for us &
 one for himself P.M. C got shell shod & picked stones off wheat
 Sunday 7 I, Nancy & my Mother went to ^{clear up Prop} meeting at Maduron,
 Lords supper was celebrated went to Christian
 Burkholder's at Uncle Joseph's place W. Cloudy rained P.M.
 8 I & Nancy started at 4 A.M. went to Finlans then they
 went with us Benny Picking into Whitcomb didn't get
 many got a good few Hazel nuts had a fine day & a
 Pleasant time. W. Cool this morning, beautiful today
 C helped B.M. N. Plow
 9 C finished picking stones off wheat then we fixed some
 fence A.M. Cleaned wheat P.M. W. fine clear
 10 I took 52 bus 50 lbs. Goodwell wheat to Major Mills @ \$1.23 per
 bus I sold it last week it is about 2.00 higher at the present time
 C helped M. Dyke thresh, I took a gift to Cal. Grove P.M.
 W. fine
