18 went to J Lehman's W. East wind. some snow coming home  
19 helped M Dyke clean pens measured up 81 bus W. fine Cl

20 I & M Dykes went to B & D's this morning to sign lease  
I went to Cedar Grove. Chord P M. commenced to make a  
fish net for B & M. soft snow, heavy this evening
