

Mon 18 dreadful hot - Arthur started plough
opposite the school house. Well went to
church at Martin Wells. rained Sunday night
Clara & Tom never got away from the other house
eleven o'clock. Just poured & to dark & sleeping
in the house we kept a light burning part of
the night. I canned up the basket of white
peaches & the basket of pears. Marjorie gave us
Hull 19 very muddy & hot - but not so hot as yesterday.
Marjorie & Hattie went after peaches got them
at Monroe for 25¢ per basket. Hattie got 4 baskets
& Marjorie got 2. they went to Eden Wells in tractor
had 4 3/4 @ 24. 114 got 25¢ per bushel sugar corn started
for cents. Linnen 19 mixed price 5. I churned &
killed a chicken & picked it, fried it for supper
& canned a few more to fill a jar partly filled
Paul down to the marsh. Paul picked a basket of
mushrooms & walked to Chippawa & got 75¢
for them & got home before them pretty good half day
work sold them at Powell's. Hattie stayed all night
Wed 20 wind west & cold got so cold we had frost
at we had to get all the plants in at night.
Hattie helped me in with them. Paul picked
two baskets of mushrooms & went to Chippawa
& sold them for 1.65. Marjorie went down & went
over the river got Paul's overalls came back &
stayed at Jennie's Hammett. I canned up 6 gals
of peaches had to work the butter & put on a crock 44

we got .50 @ 28 sugar. 1 lb of for the calf had 4 1/2 lb
butter @ 22. 99¢ when Paul came home Arthur asked
their clover seed with 7 fifty white his father
ploughed.
Thurs 21 Terrible high south west wind blew. Terrible
fire back here in the about getting a turkey & the
look out the honey. Marjorie come home with Tommy
Dell. Arthur ploughed, harrowed, & rolled it in
four days. He says it ploughs hard besides
drawing out the pile of manure that stood
down there. I churned after I put out the flowers
& swept both rooms & swept the wood out of the
penn room & peeled 8 3/4 small windows & preserved
them & boiled over some chile sauce & put it on
glass jars. Paul drew up some rails after
dinner. Frank & Herb in the other house tonight.
Friday 22, Thirty one years ago today Will was
married. Arthur harrowing & rolling all day
Terrible high wind all day from the west gets
quite cool towards night. looks stormy & sprinkly
rain. I worked the butter then peeled peaches
after dinner finished the peaches then went & swept
& dusted the school house. Marjorie cleaned some
mushrooms for supper. Marjorie mended Paul pants
all the afternoon she washed them before dinner. Will
burning brush where the fence stood & Paul drew
up nearly all the brush & they burnt it on the
ground Marjorie tel sponge at night. I peeled
pears in day. Marjorie brought the mail she got 27
