I canned over some beans that had one rubber on, made
a thing cake, looked like jam last night - but passed over
our rain so long everything dried up & dust in East. There has
a cold ~~come~~ the 11 getting ready to go to Toronto ^{comp} July 12th.
Thurs 14. I churned in the forenoon. afternoon Lilly went over to the
other house this afternoon I up to George's at night Mrs. Rose called
got dinner. called Mrs. Lill went to Chippewa took a dog, eggs &
four loaves of bread. & a letter from Lena telling she was coming
I made an apple pie for dinner

Friday 14. I made up some green tomato pickles & peeled a lot of our
own tomatoes cooked them down in tin on steam of apple sauce. Made
cookies & peach tart. made a really apple sauce. swept & cleaned the
dining room. Margaret swept the parlour room & made starch for her
clothes she wore on Pelham & armed some of them the children
swept the yard & pulled a lot of weeds then went to the school house
to have their pictures taken. Hallie went to Clifton to go to Toron.

Sat 17. Margaret baked bread done some more washing after dinner went
after Lena. Margaret Dr. Keown came after butter got 2 lbs at 20c. took down
with Margaret. I made 3 apple pies, cleaned the sausage & made an
sausage cake. swept the kitchen cleaned the boards swept the yard & churned
washed the churn bedded the calf & pigs cleaned the lamp washed the windows
& carried two pails of water from over the brook down all that from
the cake when she was in Chippewa. Paul came back from Beadley
got through hauling sand for their barn floor. Lena came back
the same as ever, cold at night - like first - Margaret 3 to butter
got 2 from sugar 25c. cheese 14c. matches 5 fly

Sun 19. Lena in the other house in dinner. I supper. Ready to
girl brought Margaret Parker to Drills. Lena ^{ably the came on} had a long talk

Mon 20 Paul killed the big Plymouth rock hen & I dressed her for
dinner she was terribly fat - after dinner Margaret took her
to Chippewa to go home. Paul went to the Falls to get
a job but got one Arthur & Lucy cutting corn. I churned
Tue 21. Paul started on the bridge. Margaret got up & got her
breakfast for him they are cutting corn yet. Margaret
went to Chippewa she & breaded wheat - works got 2 ^{from}
gave 100 with my money & 100 of Paul money she saved by
getting his under wear with butter & 50 of Mr. Keown butter
money

Wed 22. Margaret went to Hewitt after tomatoes 3 basket
took 2 lbs butter to Dr. Keown for their shoes tomorrow
paid for the tomatoes out of it. He drew a barrel of
water from the brook high ¹²³ almost a gal. Margaret
baked bread & churned. Will & Arthur tended to the pigs
Thurs 23. a beautiful rain had thousands of good
everything just dried up & covered with dust

Friday 24. I churned in the forenoon after dinner
washed out some white clothes & enough colored things
to take up the water so I could put the tub out. Margaret
went to see Ray. Annie & Margaret came on after supper
Sat 25. I took Margaret to Chippewa after dinner to go
over the river. she swept the parlour room & earned some before
she went. I made 3 pies & a ginger cake stewed apples
swept the yard, cleaned the board & kitchen & washed
all the forenoon at colored clothes Paul bought 18c
bologna & 20c of ham. yesterday I bought 4 lb of
beef from Ben Wellich. Margaret rinsed Paul's spiced shirt

Sun 24 the dullest day I ever saw rained & poured
at times & thundered & hailed. Had an awful time to keep
the pigs dry could not do it. Annie came over & stayed all
