P.M. I went down to Colmridge's sale saw J. Beattie about M. Campbell lot. Saw Geo Stuart 5 95 we saw J. McDonald about shed manure taking without leave etc. Willie & Melville sowed and harrowed more banner oats No 1. Mary came up this morning she got at Russells goods 1 81 order to send to witness for Belgians etc \$8.00 cost 7 cts also got stamps 9 cts. we paid M \$100.5 I drove down at night took to F & S 5 doz eggs 8 07 @ 1.40 got bushel timothy \$4.00 1/4 bushel - alike \$3.50 onions 32 cts balance \$6.42 m. for got at Simons credit for eggs took yesterday \$3.36 got 1/2 bushel clover \$7.13. (matches 15 got yesterday) balance \$3.92 m. for a lamb had 2 lambs in bush to-day both died</p>
