Wednesday

Fine sunny warm day. We cut in T.L. field all day I stoked. Gals brought over our tea in evening took picture of horses in binder bush for back ground etc.

16

Thursday

Fine sunny warm day. We finished cutting and stoking outs in T.L. field to-day. Willie drove down after dinner and got at Mennies 1 gal cool oil 23 lantern glass 8 15 lbs turmeric. Bella and Mary down in PM got Russells dry goods mafe at Armstrongs tomato 5 cts pearline 5 cts

Friday

Fine day cloudy at times looked like rain. warm. We hauled in 8 or 9 loads outs from No 1 to-day. Father and mother up in P.M.

18

Saturday

Cloudy and sunny very warm. Jim Fernald up all day scuffed rope and M helped with stews in PM. We cut and stoked wheat in AM hauled in 7 loads outs No 1 in PM. Mary down town and M got groceries at Fords 25 dress goods hats 70 cts hats Paid Jim mafe 25 cts stoked light evening no rain.
