Fine sunny day. Willie finished cutting No 1 and after tea we started Town Linefield I stocked all day. Bella down town in PM got at Dawgs 6 films 35cts pumpkins 5cts tea at 70cts 20 Mrs Quarie Lizzie M. Donald and Ruby Allen here for tea. Bella took Kodak picture of them Ruby on "Jack" others standing around etc. Mrs Dunn over in evening brought basket red astracan apples.

Wednesday

Fine sunny warm day. We cut in L. field all day I stocked. Gies brought over our tea in evening took picture of horses in bridle bush for back ground etc.

16

Thursday

Fine sunny warm day. We finished cutting and stocking oats in 1/2 field to-day. Willie drove down after dinner and got at Stevens 1 gal cool oil 23 Canning glass & 15 lbs turnip cake. Bella and Mary down in PM got Russells dry goods in safe at Armstrongs tomatoes 5cts pearl onions 5cts

Friday

Fine day cloudy at times looked like rain-warm. We hauled in 8 or 9 loads oats from No 1 to-day. Father and mother up in PM.

18

Saturday

Cloudy and sunny very warm. Jim Fernal up all day scuffed rope and I helped with chores in PM. We cut and stocked wheat in AM hauled in 7 loads oats No 1 in PM. Mary downtown and we got groceries at 70cts 25 dries goods 5cts 70dubiles Paid Jim in safe 25cts I think likely owing more.
