Frost last night thawing but cooler cloudy most day some parts of road dry others wet and slushy. Some people plowing. We hauled back to 7 1/2 field 4 small loads manure on waggon around by Pondar St. We sold Jess Bowley seed oats 15 bushels and 24 lbs @ 41¢ @ 4.43 - I drove May down at night. I got from J. J. Hamilton for oats sold him on 16th @ 8.20. I ordered lumber and at Armstrongs
