26 Fine cool day. The weather has been pleasantly cool since Tuesday. I was not to morning service. Mrs & Mr Given came home last night

27 Marion is out so well today. Mice & cock Ro and Murky are taking in straw wood to the shed, from the field, by the barn Jennie got table & jetty stool at Jays

28 Cold and wet began to rain last evening and so on 1 P. M. shower we have a fire in the sitting room Pa paid Dan \$5.00 on our account

29 Wednesday. I was not at Prayer Meeting Mrs Patton of Maxville called to see Marion, she said her trouble was from the teeth

30 Rained

31 A reservoir in the Alleghany Mountains broke today and drowned a great many people in the city of Johnston

June 1st It is said between 1500 and 2000 were drowned in Johnston June 3rd. They say there 8 or 10 were drowned by the flood
