Heavy rain began to day

- Sept 19 Went to Somerville with Robert Armstrong to the cattle.  
sheep came home with him slept all night there.
- 20 came home to day from young in the forenoon worked  
at the church with S. McConnell & Carpenter Mr. Mc-  
Cormick & Mr. Rennell Mr. Wier made a bridge  
in front of the church & drew 5 loads of <sup>dung</sup> sand  
21 drew water for the house then 2 loads of sand  
for S. & Bradley 40 bushel drew rails for  
to fix the fence round the corn.
22. Revd Mr. Wier preached this morning & Mr.  
Toplin in the evening.
- 23 drew 4 loads of dung out of the new Cow  
Stable in the forenoon cut the last of the corn
- 24 drew 4 loads of dung from the hog pen to the garden  
separated the lambs from the sheep a marked <sup>from</sup>  
heavy rain this afternoon drew 3 loads <sup>to the stable</sup> of stones
- 25 drew 9 loads of stones to the Stable
- 26 do 7 do 9 do in the forenoon
- 27 picked the stones of the church floor &  
planned & scraped a ditch in it
- 28 the Revd Mr. Toplin preached this morning heavy  
rain in the afternoon & at night no meeting I  
went down to the Schoolhouse <sup>the</sup> stone come up  
30 drew 7 loads of sand & gravel to the Barn yard
