Mr James Cameron the 2nd 1871
Sunday Livin in Gordon and Bismarck
went up to Salmon River to see Lis & Fine
Dag. Rained some Tom Kennedy and Rooker
here wanting Pasture for their sheep
Gordon close to the Royal Spotted Colored to
Dag a Heifer calf 3rd Gordon and I to Ross Island
to see if we could find some fat Pines Stumps
got some fat 4 staves large ones and 2 small ones
killed some Black Snakes Trowled some
to Dag for the first but got no Bites high
East Wind went to Charles Island the
(Butternut) Julia Marville and Galerneau here
Sunday Looking for Bald they saw
he has left her shot some of those Sparrows
Black Birds a great many on the water to
Day splitting up Fat Pine Planted Citrons and
Water melons to Day Potatoes coming up some Gordon
Broke the hoe Piled up the Big staves 4
Good ones 70 odd ones of small ones John
Sandfield old Donald Bwood to Day
4th Began to Heap up manure at the East end of
the Barn dug this Piece just 50 odd bushels Beans
sowed some Scarlet Hatfield Rita Bagas seeds commencing
showing the Weedon the Potatoes Fishing alone got
10 pieces of fish & 8 lbs succours Kerch Lost a Sturgeon
brought my Ashes to the River caught 7 Planks
Lots of Kailbush going Down to Day Washed the
Wooll Fine Flies commenced to show or
Lightning Bugs Cut some Brush at the Lower
Looking for the Ram found him Dead up at the
East side of the Big theory Elm nuts falling Ragons Plenty

that I could find the right time to leave the house
of both the water and the air. I saw the day turned
the water warm to day I found in now made
the water of hay but the weeds around the potatoes
the water change with the water.

Mr. M. W. Allen's Journal June 8th 1872
White washed the Cook house fixing the tools up
Dug some at the River cleared away stones to
not hurt the Bottom of the Boats or canoes
about many Propellers and Boats a Towning up
to Day Sprung Faggot some great Pine
for grapes growing 9th Sunday forenoon and Monday
I went around Anna Howitt's Island 10th Brushing
made a fence at the West End of the Barn
Mr Crippin and Mr Paddock here I rowling
Brought nuts and sweetmeats to the children
Left his 9th 11th Cutting some brush hoeing some
12th Our Keeper calved Robert Smiley's
Departed 13th Brushing 14th Went with 5 Bags
of ashes 8 Bushels to Jimmy Grant did not hear
of Robt's death till I seen the Funeral folks
There stopt in the ashery Jim Hopkins
and till the Funeral was over
to 1 Rent of Whiskey Bought 7 beyond
1 Dollars worth of Tin Basin 1 Gun having Brother John
1 Dg Eggs for her to hatch Heard the Kingston
was burnt 15th Cutting Weeds & Brush
Windy set the Hen to hatch 16th Caught the
Raft 2 men came and told me to take care
of it till Thursday I took the sail and Rope of
the Raft to the house and pulled by Block very
Warm Day sleeping made the 8th on this day the
ever memorable Battle of Waterloo Began 17th
Began to wean Bismarck not to say very
Bad Went with 6 1/2 Bushels of ashes Bought of
Garden thread 2 1/2 lbs 1 lbner 3 yds of linen for
