

Sunday 29th. Warm, a thunder storm last night and during early morn.

Monday 30th. Morning fine and warm afternoon raining. Rose of a bull calf last night. Logging up fragments in the morning. To die. Then for some time.

Tuesday 1st. Fine and warm. Father, Fred and I pulling and drawing home weeds. Robert cutting loggins for fence. In afternoon Father after by trees Robert staking fence. Fred and Phil leaving away stumps and other materials from where the stock stood. I went to take Peter's master's talk of stone in afternoon. I lit and put up a piece of fence near the road on the bank. Planted some sweetish turnips for seed in Calypso tonight of the morn. Mat.

Wednesday 2nd. Fine and warm. Father, me and Fred going about to put up boundary fence. Robert and Fred getting stakes out of the swamp, leveling ground of turnips in clearing preparing to the swamp of grain.

Thursday 3rd. Warm and pleasant. Father, Phil and me helping Stuart to put up fence finished in the afternoon. Robert and Fred levelling knowls of earth. Phil drew some splinters or stakes after the fence was finished. John Golbe had 12 bushel of wheat not yet.

Friday 4th. Fine with north wind what made it pleasant working. Logging sweetish turnips. Uncle John had 1 bushel of wheat. Burnt some brush last night.

Saturday 5th. Fine and cool in the morning warm during the day. Logging for stiles altered the calf and pig.

Sunday 6th. Dull and cool, much ice on the lake.

Monday 7th. Dull, cold with north wind N.E. East
