to see Edith Mitchell. Stayed quite a while she looks very thin.

Thurs 21<sup>st</sup> Feb 89. Pa cleaning stove pipes & I cleaning rooms. very busy all day. Emily Gilder &  
her father come then C. Ryan. Annie & Co. went to church. Henry got shoes fixed Woodlands  
Eula called. W. W. come home. I very tired done baking after got through cleaning.
