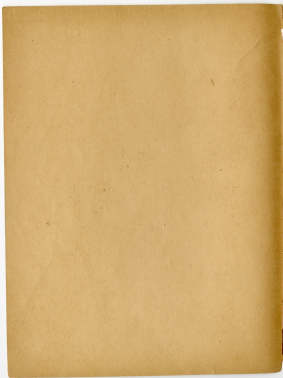

- Nov Jan 3. Clouded and very mild, Willie called with post.
Mr. Robert died. Sigge Rasmussen called. Aunt Nellie at R.R.
station for parcel.
- Nov Jan 4. Fine and mild, sleighing nearly all day. Aunt Mattie
called at Mr. Kelly's and Mr. Leonard. The girls
here in evening, rain, and sleeted in night.
- Nov Jan 5. Rained and sleeted nearly all day. Aunt Mattie
but was sick all night. Helene, Mary Cook
and Minnie Taylor called.
- Nov Jan 6. Fine and frozen clear but icy. I called at Mother's
and at bank. Mr. Pallas called.
- Nov Jan 7. Fine but cold. Aunt Nellie at morning church.
I went to evening church. Annie and Sigge called.
- Nov Jan 8. Fine but cold. We washed. Aunt Mattie called
at Mr. Redden. Mattie and children here in eve.
- Nov Jan 9. Fine and milder.
- Nov Jan 10. A very cold north wind blowing at first. Sigge
called to my good bye. She was married at
five o'clock. We got our first egg.

sloppy.

Feb Mar 7. Cold wind but taking the snow. The water
raised and nearly too road but made long
ditch and got it away quickly.

Feb Mar 8. Fine bright day and mild. Sleighing nearly
gone and many tugged out. I was at bank for
at which on morning started to cut in ice.

Feb Mar 9. Mild and misty. When started to rain at noon

on timber stove at five o'clock.

Mon Mar 19 Fine but cold - down to zero in morning. Aunt Mattie called to see Mrs Kelly and at Mother's. Mrs Martin and Mrs Burr called.

Tue Mar 20 Fine and bright, roads muddy. Aunt Nellie and I at Dr Langstaffs funeral. John Cook here for tea. a little.

Wed Mar 21 Fine and warmer. Mrs Atkinson called. Aunt Nellie and I went out to service, but none.

Thu Mar 22 Fine and moderately warm, roads here muddy. We all went to Town. Aunt Mattie - got a new jacket black moire. Annie here in the evening. Robes and Black-birds.

Fri Mar 23 Fine at first then started to rain. Mrs White called. Aunt Mattie clearing cellar headway. Then we washed kitchen walls. Aunt Nellie and I went out to Millinery shop. Thunder and rain in evening. Mrs Clarke - and William here in evening.

Sat March Fine but cold wind all day skating at the
tank but soft. Annie and Maggie called in
the afternoon.

Sund March Fine and bright. Aunt Nellie and I at
morning church. I went to evening church.
Annie had roses. Gurnace let out.

Tues March Fine and very warm. Mrs Danden and some
tea. Ice put day out. Maggie and Jimmy showed
she Nelson Nellie called. Will get her here

Wed March Rained heavily most of the day, then a very
heavy wind and blizzard. Aunt Nellie out. W.C.
meeting, we put on coal ashes.

Thurs March Fine but a heavy wind. Ice return landing.

Fri March Fine but very windy, and cold. Annie called also
Mrs Robb's. Mrs Nelson called. Rained through night

Sat March Fine and bright. I went to see Walter Gandy
about fixing return. called at Milliner's.

Sat March Fine and mild until we had a little shower.

Sund April 1. April fool. much warmer but dark, became
here all morning. Rained heavily in afternoon.

the return day, as it leaked and going to
town it concentered. We washed.

 we pumped again to and by sixteen ^{inches} for son's trip.
- Fri Apr 6. Good Friday. Rained and drizzled most of day
 and terribly shabby. we pumped dry again.
 Tommie here in morning. Louise here in afternoon.
- Sat Apr 7. Very cold N.W. wind. Mr. Suresky commented.
 Sister Katie Chapman here in afternoon.
- Sun Apr 8. Easter Sunday. Aunt Nellie and I at church.
 cold wind but bright. we went to evening church.
 Tommie called in the afternoon.
- Mon Apr 9. Fine but very, very cold and quite a frost. Aunt
 & David called. Willie and I went out to Aunt Wiggins for
 tea. Easter Monday. Got paid for work done.
- Tues Apr 10. Fine but very cold with high wind. I started

- Fri May 4 Fine and bright. Mrs. Cox and daughter called, also Mrs. Pablin and Miss Pablin in the evening. We planted peas.
- Sat May 5 Rained gently most of the day from east. I called at Mrs. C. tomorrow in afternoon.
- Sund May 6 Dull and cool east wind. Mrs. Davidson and her son on the morning. I went to Wilks for tea and to Memorial Service for Elders Board. Aunt Willie at ev. church. Annie called in afternoon.

- Mon May 7 Fine and moderately warm. Aunt Mattie pointed
out Grandmother. Mrs. Peckham called. Aunt Mattie
at Miss Foley's in the evening.
- Tue May 8 Fine and quite warm. packed boxes for
the boys. Aunt Nellie at the Cross Meeting
in the evening. Aunt Mattie and I at Mrs
Littles in the evening. trees come.
- Wed May 9 Aunt Nellie went to Toronto to Aunt Lizzie

showers in afternoon. then colder.

of rain. Mr. and Mrs. Peckham here for tea.

- Sun May 13 Fine and a little warmer. Aunt Mattie at
morning church. Mother, Maria, Lizzie and Wyles
called. We all went to evening church. the first
time for Aunt Mattie. very quiet.

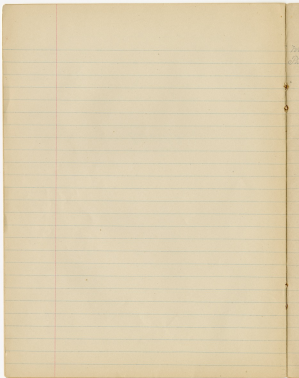
