got windy at night rained a little. Willie
plowed 4 horses No 7 all day I worked at
henhouse boarding inside. Sheep died on rope

Hard frost last night fine sunny A.M.
same P.M. except snow flurries intervals
Willie finished plowing No 7 W and
plowed some of 7 I again A.M. and I worked
at henhouse skinned sheep etc. P.M.
we both plowed single teams finished nearly
even next handwood bank headland etc. W and plowed some
of alfalfa 7 I. Mother & Mrs Ritchie up for tea Willie drove them
down took rest of Mrs Ritchie stuff down she is under own horse last night returned
Mary helped Mrs Enarise pick apples Willie hauled them in for her
after she brought in bags up here.

Saturday

Windy, cold, sunny. Frost last night. We brought
over load hay from other barn. Willie plowed 7 I. I worked at henhouse
I went down town at night bought at Morris 2 flour belts 20 etc at McDemonts
one for and buy and 10 etc We shut barn in over henhouse to-night
