 and girls set potatoes. P.M. we worked
 some more land made some more drills
 got some more drills plowed as follows now
 5 corners 6 from bottom next roads up to within
 line of stake of fence with nail in it to nearest
 poplar tree in bush Doolay from there
 head of Henry two lines North side of barn. rest and
 all of 7 corners rows 8 and 9 gold corn.
 May down town P.M. Lucy in buggy got at
 Stals crock for Phillips butter 60¢ wall 60
 paper Phillips got last used \$2.00 Paint Menis 45¢ of 20
 Wm. Ryens over at night altered lambs and calf. 2 00

June 1 Tuesday
 Fine sunny A.M. clouded over rained some
 about 6 o'clock and later. Willie hauled 2
 loads manure from Franks to-day we
 spread them in new orchard I disbed and
 rolled it A.M. and in P.M. spread with spreader
 5 loads from yard. Willie and Peter
 Clark worked the 20 sheep in P.M. at home
 paid him \$1.00. Peter Spark and two boys
 George & Arthur down to day. Willie down town
 at night ordering new suit. Willie got A.M.
 bolts at Menin for linen 16 corn 15 wheat 1.00 at
 Armstrong on offer. I sold to my near-neighborhood 20.00
