Another cloudy day mizzling at times. a few glimpses sunshine. Willie sick to-day R R came up in morning but went home again. I cut partly around hay No 2 then quit, raining. We chopped etc to-day. I scuffled 4 rows turnips then quit too wet. Willie drove Mary down. P.M. to dentist he got at 7 & 8 com 92cts. Mary stayed down all night.

More rain last night cloudy and sunny exceedingly heavy showers late P.M. about 5 o'clock. Willie drove down brought up Mary in morning. We cleaned up barn floor etc. P.M. we put Paris green on potatoes from S S to other barn with lime but were stopped by rain which washed it all off again. Mary sent parcel to Esters to exchange wet suits. Wm Clark eggs 40cts. Mary got her false teeth to-day. Willie had Kate & Mand up to Rogersons. 2 27 got wheat at J Blackes \$12 50 bushel.
