Surgical Suggestions.

The best routine management of the bowels after operation is to let them alone. An enema on the third or fourth day is usually all that is needed.

Marked post-operative abdominal distention, with nausea, belching and increasing prostration are strongly suggestive of acute dilatation of the stomach. The stomach tube and lavage are indicated as they are also in repeated post-operative vomiting.—*Amer. Journ. of Surg.*
