bought of Mr Ward RRR 25 3<sup>rd</sup> pools 15 Paid this  
bought of Summers Bottling select Kork 25 paid  
bought of Nicholsons Almanack 5 cents paid Bought  
pair of Boots not paid till I see if they suit  
got a letter from Williamstown to Epiphany went  
to Williamstown & W Frosty at John Angus place  
brought 2 lbs sugar Wine snowing some 7<sup>th</sup>  
came home from Williamstown got a Ride  
parish hall from John Angus got a  
letter of 12 lbs from Mr Grant  
talking to me about a Horse 80 Dollars  
at Roses kind of hail soft 8<sup>th</sup> Sunday  
Hallowmas Birth Day Fine cold some snow Jordan  
and Davy Spunk here 9<sup>th</sup> Fixing around the Barn  
frosty cold set traps for the Mink 10<sup>th</sup> Wind Snowing  
blowing turned fine bushed some of our Road up  
the Bay Leander got a Mink and 2 Mink Kats  
Day skinned the Mink and Kat for him  
Cold Frosty Windy sawing Making sticks for the churn  
asher 12<sup>th</sup> Election Court in Cornwall Scrooped  
Summerstown Bought of Nicholsons 2 pair not  
paid as I think I will Return 1 pair (soda 10 plates 5  
boards paid this) 13<sup>th</sup> Windy Raining Putting in  
day 14<sup>th</sup> Brought a pair of Boots Back to Nichol  
bought a 100 lb of Flour 2<sup>nd</sup> 30 not paid Bought  
of Mr Ward a pair of Boots 75 on credit  
Leander sold his Kats 25 for 11 a piece paid <sup>2-75</sup>  
Mink not sold Paid on the 12<sup>th</sup> What  
owed Nicholsons 2<sup>nd</sup> 82 and a pair of Boots  
I got on the 5<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 20

Fine East Wind and changed to West commenced  
 snow kind of soft water Raising close to Shore  
 Drove up the Buns and turned them over soon  
 Ducks Flying about Large an hole Before the  
 Door Windy high tonight In stung and Frosty  
 29<sup>th</sup> Our Angus Birth Day Windy Frosty  
 Drifting Reading Papers a Mock Sun on the East side  
 of the sun 30<sup>th</sup> spilling stove <sup>wood</sup> West Wind Frosty  
 Frosty night 2 Mock suns 31<sup>st</sup> Brake on a 3 Ton stove  
 to Day East Wind Frosty cold sleigh crossing  
 Summers town Road on the ice Feeding the  
 cattle extra Last Day of the year

1<sup>st</sup> of January New Years Day 1888  
 Sunday a Fortunate Day Windy turned Fine  
 Fernandez went off we did not know he  
 went 2<sup>nd</sup> Cold some So Lemay and Amiot here  
 took their Dinner There w/ Fishing Elsin the  
 mud got 6 from them Brought our Livestock  
 home gave him a Key to Fire of my chest  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Allen's Birth Day Leander crossed to Summers  
 Bought of Summers <sup>1853</sup> Tea 57 Needles 5 Threads 1 Box  
 of Mr Ward camphor 5 Sweets 2 Heard that  
 Mr Stillwell Left the place Franky  
 Leplante seen Fernandez in the Cove  
 got an almanack got a Letter from D W  
 Fin it and a Christmas card not very well  
 Bad with Rheumatism Teams crossing now  
 4<sup>th</sup> a Fine Day E W a Great many Fishing  
 Leander and John Fishing Ello got 9
