

Thursday, Nov 5th 1903 fair

we finished roots & fixing fence around pits & turnip patch in morning and worked at wire fence in afternoon
Dow here in afternoon

Friday 6th fine Cold
we worked at wire fence all day Dow did not come
we strung wires on road going down towards brewery.

Saturday 7th fine but Cold
we worked at wire fence finished the piece we were at yesterday and started a piece along side no 3 Paidey rd
paid Jonnie Flick for working last Saturday 34¢
smiths have taken wood for Culvert, for \$1.50 they have not paid for it yet.

Sunday 8th fair
Father Mary, E. & I went to Church in morning and Children & I to S.S.

Monday 9th fine
We worked at fence all day

Tuesday 10th fine
We worked at fence all day finished stretching wire and gathered up most of the lumber and posts.

Wednesday 11th fair & Rain at night
Geo plowed head land around no 1. Father chored & hauled off some twitch grass roots I chored all day, went to town in evening got coil. 92¢
bgt wire, 76¢, at acorn's pit mended 05, harness mended 05
