at George Renshaws got from a Baker 100 lbs  
of 4 four andrew at the Examination  
got some Herrings and Pork from George  
stop at Hamiltons and Tommy Jack  
went up with the Horses after my  
4 four Gordon came with me to the  
head of the Island to draw the sledge  
Very Cold East Wind and Frosty Jim Hopkins  
went to Cornwall with John Summers  
23<sup>rd</sup> Cold chopping at the Door Rased my  
Long canoe and Dressed the small canoe  
up on the Bank Randolph and  
took up my sail on Air hole in front  
of the house 24 Sunday Reading papers  
Christmas Eve Cold and Windy sun shone  
25<sup>th</sup> Christmas Day a Fine Day Gordon  
came from Hamilton took a Boat  
with him had a pair of scatis with him  
26<sup>th</sup> kind of Fine and stormy East Wind not  
very well George Renshaw a Bee Drawing  
stones chopping stove Wood feeding the 2  
cows the Hay 27<sup>th</sup> crossed to Summers town  
Bought a Lamp Chimney  
attached pipe seen Men gathering  
money for Mrs Cruick Monument  
Tom Summers Bushing the Road  
on the ice Charlie Parisha taking his  
cattle 4 some Hamilton that he Bought  
28<sup>th</sup> Cutting in the Bush 29<sup>th</sup> Out in the  
Bath Day turned very stormy to night  
from the East snowing and drifting 30<sup>th</sup>  
Went to the Pitt Road for Cedar stormy  
from the north West Blustering to have  
away Banks of snow around the Barn  
and on the Road to the River 31<sup>st</sup> Sunday  
very Cold Last Day of the year
