 Good Friday Went to a fine evening McGongalls and

 snowed some to night 31st Leander crooked for Marshall did not get the Toronto Paper heard Russell was
 elected Bought of I Summers a Bottle of Electroine and
 25 cents paid Windy 1st of April all Tools Day Easter
 Sunday Fine Lewis wife and 2 children here and
 James Mr. Dougall and Andy Cameron here wanting one of the girls 2nd Leander Capt
 10 trees in sugar Bush cutting wood at the Camp 7th
 3rd Fine One of George Bodells Boys here Lewis went
 to Buy Hay 2 Indians at the Lower Point want
 to Stop in the Shanty they went to Lewis house
 in the Bush cut a pole for the camp cutting firewood
 sawed some old Logs at the camp Capt 18 trees
 to day began the hay on the Stable Loft yesterday
 took 2 pots to the Bush and a barrel gathered to
 12 pails since yesterday 4th Starved Day 2nd Day
 First Boiling in the Bush about 28 trees tapped
 made 2 gallons put up a new Pole at the Camp
 Teams or cutters crooking Summers Road onto Bottach
 Tom Tailed Black Birds Phoebe or Pewits Grassbirds
 seen some Black Ducks Frog Hawk Hen Hawk
 Red coat Blackbirds came ice opening close at shore
 at the Lower Point Northern Lights Aurora Borealis Merry Day
 2 nights ago lots of snow in the Bush Day then commenced
 yesterday for the first to day 5th Morning 6th Made
 1/2 gallons of syrup turned all in sugar 18 lbs 7th
 Leander crooked to Summerstown Bought of
 I Summers a Box of Mathes 10 cents paid
 at the Papers 8th Low Sunday Fine cold made
 later on the snow Leander and Lewis went to
 Ross Island the House taken away

 Fine & W Gordon here for an Ell Spear cutting Wood
 at the Camp put a new handle in the Ell Spear & pails
 in the pots of sap 10th Fine Boiling sap commenced to rain
 ice not very good using hay the stable Loft ice
 opened to day 11th Raising a Lamb to day a strip
 open to the end of the Island 12th Made 2 gallons today
 of Syrup took some of the stuff out of the cookhouse
 slowed some fine freezing some shooting in the
 morning Windy Sonia went to the sugar Bush to day
 a strip open to day in the channel to the Lighthouse
 13th Fine Oxley calved Boiling in the sugar Bush ice
 Jamming of ice ^{filled up} _{small bushes from} before the door cows crooked to the
 Pitt Pocket 14th East Wind snowing some Boiling some
 The rain started from before the door commenced the
 marsh hay on the North East side the stack 25 pails on
 the fire to night seen a light last night coming
 from the head of Plum Island it must be a
 Sighn of — or forerunner of Death 15th Made
 about 18 lbs in the Bush Heighton made 5 lbs at the house
 Fine 16th Killed oxley Calve gave him to the Dogs as
 the went the Mill for the Lamb Boiling Day Fine
 some grains of snow took up 2 bushels of pine from
 the shanty ice going down and jamming 17th Seen
 Lewis on Christee Island crooking to Summerstown ice
 jamming I went around the Island crust good
 this morning in the sugar Bush made 4 gallons
 of molasses to day heard Loons for the first
 time Sumac bush cleaning some around the
 Hickorys on the Hill 18th Old Duncan's B Day
 the Windy Rained hard taking manure from the
 apple trees boiling but did not finish 2 Rainbows
 taking the stove wood from the upper end of the house
 to ice going down River clear
