Fine sunny morning clouded over rained and hailed about noon rained a little after dinner warm sun but cool day. Mr Barbour got team this AM to plow Willie finished harrowing No 5 and strip N of No bush Mr Faunt over AM I gave him 2 1/2 bushels foanette oats he paid me \$1.25 balance in trade sold him 100 lbs hay 60 cts. P.M. we spread 10 loads manure 3 in N orchard 7 in No 2 W Willie drove down at night Lucy in buggy

Thursday

Mostly sunny, and cloudy cold & windy. Harry Armstrong came in in morning to tell us D. B. Scotts fertilizer was at station so Willie drove to station got half ton bone flour gave cheque \$18.19 on R.B which included the dollar I borrowed from him Sunday April 1st the bag flour Mary got May 2nd at P & L he brought up also 2 bags shorts \$4.40 also 2 lbs mangel seed 80 cts paid \$1.00 out it and the egg took down leaving 120 balance on fe he also got turnip seed 3 lbs at Russell on fe he then took 5 pigs down sold to Cameron 880 lbs @ \$16.25 per unit \$143.00 weighing 10 cts. I disked N. D orchard A.M. P.M I cultivated Mr Barbour's outland with Peter Hamilton's seeder put in 3 hours at it it was soft and wet. Willie rolled hay land No 6 P.M. The girls cut out lilacs trimmed evergreens and leveled earth over septic tank etc. Willie drove Mary down at night Lucy in buggy.
