- Oct 1. Took two oak logs of the old Shop & hewed them for the groups of the corn stable they are very hard
- 2 I had to see about getting the pulpit fixed & then fixing & killed a sheep
- 3 went to Garraquee to the Fair it was a good one there was a grate many people there heavy rain middle of the day
- 4 attended the opening of our Church the Revd Mr Wilson of Kingston preached & the Revd Mr Gordon assisted fine day there was 19 dollars & 6 collected
- 5 drew 4 loads of sand for S. Stacy 35 bushel 80¢ time 1.25 in the forenoon attended an agriculture meeting in the afternoon
- 6 the Revd Mr Wier dispensed Sacrament in the Church Revd Mr Gordon assisted
- 7 <sup>Revd Mr Kirk</sup> preached all night in the <sup>St. Pauls</sup> hall fixed the barn & granary for the thrasher heavy rain with thunder & lightning last night & rained all day to day Mr Davis came with the horse power this evening
- 8 brought the thrasher this morning got all done by noon peas & oats I went to the Station with Mr Gordon he went on the express
- 9 got some wood in the forenoon fixed the doreshed for the straw in the afternoon fine day
- 10 rain all the forenoon went to the Shop there was a great many people there in the forenoon & allow the rain came down till noon at noon waggon & come Buzzys came in three <sup>loaded</sup> & four
- 11 drew 3 loads of sand for St. Mc Kay 160 bushel in the forenoon fine rain <sup>the afternoon</sup> the forenoon
- 12 helped S. Sabonster to thrash fine day Ellen & James Beatty went to young to see Aunt Isabella we hear that she is very sick
- the Revd Mr Robinson preached this morning rained all day no work done except getting
