19 Do do do Do they finished he sowed 7 bushel of wheat
20 same in all 1 bushel of Black Barley and about ¼ of flat seed
on the express that furnished all the sowing there fine weather
21 AD is helping Johnson to plow
22 Do Do Do Do frost last night Johnson planted
beans in the garden
23 Rev W. Millard preached this evening
24 AD helped John Johnson at his work plowing & chaging
25 John rolled in the North field AD went to granary this afternoon long time
26 John & Johnson started corn blaw but a few AD started the bed down
27 John raised the middle bed then drove down from AD to the North side
28 AD drew all the dung that was at his place a lot of straw from
house on to when he sowed the wheat on the North field same spread
29 AD drew a load of straw from the barn to the field this morning
the wind was too high they could do nothing so then plowed for the
potatoes where the cow corn was last year he went to to receive of
Hedge Mr Kays

AD drew straw down to the North field and it was
the spring repeat then him & the Boys worked the sheep
AD went to the country to plow & sow corn back at night could do
