 in root field A m I helped I make wire

 30 cts for Apples & 40 cts for Peas
 for Basket containing all the month
 a week less Commission & Freight

 10 B got Frank Shed P.m.
 11 Boy plowed A m B F & H helped
 Thomas thresh Peas P.m. W Resor set
 his Steamer in field & threshed them off
 the Wagon. W. fine warm Clear
 12 Boy finished plowing Wheat stubble
 in root field I went to Doc Resor's
 this Monday A went to Dr Robinson
 P.m. he has Asthma I & B cleaned
 a lot of seed Wheat P.m. we are
 selling a good deal of Octobers
 prices W. very warm & Clear
 heavy thunder shower after dark
 Sunday 13 I & Nary went to meeting
 at Wiedeman's Old Paul Hoover &
 Elias Weber officiated. Elias
 held Sacrament to such as were
 willing to partake of it we went to
