Willie finished corn cultivating the corn AM brought the wood home with him I finished fixing the stump fence No 4 bush using the sheep gates etc. Uncle Will Paulin up for dinner had been at Sulphur on jury stayed down at home last night. he went up to Arthur with Mr Malone the mail man. PM Willie cultivated the new land piece in No 4. I churned then hoed mangels. Willie went down town at night got bread at 70cts 12-cts.
