

Wednesday Apr 23<sup>rd</sup> 1902

Tom & I took a walk over to Mr Dougall's in morning to see the stock & farm and then I went home. I lent him \$1.00, & sold a load of potatoes in afternoon to Jas Hewer for 65¢ per bu.  
31.25 <sup>40</sup>

Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> fair  
I hauled two loads of potatoes to town & bgt home 1 load of manure potatoes to Hewer. @ 65¢ 35.97  
potatoes to Thorp \$25.12

Friday 25<sup>th</sup> dull  
I shipped potatoes in morning and sold 4 bgs wheat to Jas Hewer recd \$25.00 from Thorp for potatoes. <sup>25.00</sup>

Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> wet  
Geo. hauling manure, and I went to town exchanged barley for corn, and bgt a load of oats, at 14¢ per bu

Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> fine  
Lillian & I went to Church in morning and Jimmied out to S.S.

Monday 28<sup>th</sup> fine  
Geo hauling manure all day I went to mill in morning pd for oats. 22.80 Chopping \$1.25, got \$10.95 from Jim that I paid him, to pay for oats. Tom came today and hauled manure in afternoon, I went to town bgt hardware <sup>\$2.25</sup>

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> dull wet  
Tom plowed in morning and Geo hauled manure till 3 P.M. I worked in garden and after rain came on I sheared sheep, Geo. cleaned cattle, & I chored I hauled 3 loads manure in afternoon
