Friday March 7<sup>th</sup> 1872

Alexander Stevenson arrested tonight and conveyed  
to Napanee Jail. William McDonald also looked after  
but he made his escape, all this for the severe beating  
given to Jack Connelley in the early part of Winter. he is  
still an invalid.

Saturday March 8<sup>th</sup>

Officers returned this morning and again made search  
for McDonald but by this time he is across the frontier.  
Mr Stevenson & Mr Polley went to Napanee to give bail for  
Alex but was unsuccessful - trial to be next Thursday  
Lease went to Kingston.

Monday March 10<sup>th</sup>

Weather changed thawing now fast and fields getting bare  
Polley began to plant old wheat.

Tuesday March 11<sup>th</sup>

Rain still continues water such a way where roads impassible  
Stevenson's case settled today by paying \$500. to Jack Connelley  
whom he binds himself to withdraw all actions against either  
weather changed to clear frost and snow falling
