Sun Dec 4 clear part of the and cool the Thamesville minister gave us a sermon this after noon. the roads are dry and dusty. Su

Wed Dec 7th cloudy and cool it looks as though there was a storm brewing the little snow called in this after noon

Thu Dec 8th light clouds and high wind plenty of dust. I walked over to Brother John Snarys this afternoon

Fri Dec 9th cloudy part of the day a little snow Sarah was here doing house work

Sat Dec 10th light clouds and cold, 10 deg. above zero. alone most of the day

Sun Dec 11th cloudy and cold comenced to snow this after noon. Rev W^m McMullen preached

Mon Dec 12th cloudy snowing say. Dick brought a load of wood. after noon writing to Catharine
