Victoria day. Very fine sunny day neither hot or cold & rather up all day. We piled up brush stumps etc in No 4 E and burnt them. Fred and Cameron Paulin down to day. I went with Fred to grounds in P.M. 25 cts admittance. I went down at night to go to concert but couldn't get in too crowded. Mother up in P.M.

Thursday

Fine day clouded over and rained heavy at night warm at night. Willie cultivated strip of land for corn in No 4 W in A.M. and in P.M. went down in buggy got at Mennis tar 10 cts at Armstrongs on spec. flux 3.00 2 bushels corn 1.20 carrot seed 10. then we hauled off stuff from No 4 E & rather up helping us. I went up to Allan at night paid him for oats got Dec 12 7.00 manure spreader 2.00 sows 2.00 less \$9 \$6 of which got in 7 fisher hay etc.

Willie went over and finished Fred Bowley's fence and Willie Bowley here all day helping me haul out manure we got 12 loads to corn land No 4 W then hauled some stuff of No 4 E and brought up load vines. Sold Jackson cream yesterday \$1.20 to day 35
